PROTECT...

- ... **our environment.** Medications disposed of down the toilet or in the trash end up in our water supplies and damage our environment.
- ... **our teens from an epidemic of RX abuse.** 7 of the 10 most commonly abused drugs by teenagers are prescription medications. Teens get dangerous drugs from family and friends—and their medicine cabinets.
- ... **our young children** from a leading cause of accidental poisoning.
- ... **our seniors** from misuse and mistakes.
- ... **your home.** Addicts are looking in as many medicine cabinets as possible—maybe even yours.

ACCEPTABLE

- ◆ Prescriptions- including controlled substances (*empty pills into zip-lock bag, liquids accepted mark out personal information on bottle put in zip-lock bag*)
- ◆ Over-the-counter medications
- ◆ Veterinary medications

UNACCEPTABLE

- ◆ **NO** sharps accepted
- ◆ **NO** medical waste
- ◆ **NO** aerosols or hydrogen peroxide
- ◆ **NO** other drugs (marijuana, cocaine etc)
- ◆ **NO** DEA Registrants
